



Carlsbad Wave F.C. Parent Contract

Communication Policy: When a problem arises that a parent needs to resolve, Carlsbad Wave F.C. has a policy on how to effectively address it. A parent needs to:

Discuss the problem with the Head Coach. If not resolved then...

Discuss the problem with the Director of Coaching. If not resolved then...

Discuss the problem with the Carlsbad Wave F.C. VP of Competitive Soccer.

If a problem arises between a parent or player and the coach, the parent and player must abide by the 48 hour rule. Do not approach a coach during a training session or game. You may contact the coach 48 hour after the problem to give everyone involved that cooling off period.

E-mails should be used to distribute factual information to the teams. They should not be used to air problems and opinions or distribute complaints. Please do not copy the Director of Coaching, the Head Coach, or any Board Member on such e-mails, as they will not respond to them.

General Parent/Spectator Rules:

1. Parents/Spectators (P/S) will respect the rules. One of the most important things your child will learn is respect for the rules. If you do not agree with a referees call, keep your comments to yourself. If you believe there is a serious problem, discuss it with the coach or a CWFC Board member outside of game time.
2. P/S will encourage the whole team. Do not create undo pressure for your child or the team. Give positive encouragement and support.
3. P/S will role model good sportsmanship. Help your child learn to accept losing, as this is a normal part of competition. Help them understand that they simply lost to a team that played better that day.
4. P/S will abstain from the following:
 - a. Physical abuse of player, coach, or any CWFC staff member.
 - b. Foul or obscene language and/or indecent gestures.
 - c. Being under the influence of, in possession of, or drink alcoholic beverages, as well as the possession of or use of any illegal substances at games or practice fields.
 - d. Throwing of any objects.
 - e. Arguing with opposing team's coaches or parents.
 - f. Heckling or harassing players, coaches or parents.
 - g. Entering the playing field without being authorized by a CWFC staff member.

CWFC has adopted a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. Violations will not be tolerated at any Carlsbad Wave FC function. Violations will result in benching or suspension of players and in the ejection or banning of the parent/spectator.
